City of Los Angeles Rules Regulation Installation of Neighborhood Watch Signs

Neighborhood Watch Signs should be installed on non-wooden street lighting poles. They may be installed on street lighting poles with parking restriction signs. However, they may not be installed on traffic signal poles, nor on street lighting poles with other warning, regulatory or guidance traffic signs facing the same direction. They should be installed at a clearance height greater than 7 feet so they will be less prone to vandalism. LADOT reserves the right to remove Neighborhood Watch Signs not in conformance with these guidelines.
