PROPOSED MOTION: That the GVGC Board authorizes a letter to be drafted to the Mayor of the City of Los Angeles and members of the Los Angeles City Council Public Safety Committee urging them to continue with the hiring of Police Officers. The letter will read in part: "that the Los Angeles Police Department should be allowed to continue hiring Police Officers at such a rate that would meet the staffing level of 10,000 officers policing the streets of Los Angeles as stated by the Mayor in his campaign promises. The letter would also state that the City of Los Angeles is able to recruit qualified candidates and replace those officers that retire with new recruits attending the Police Academy. This letter shall also be sent to the other Neighborhood Councils in the San Fernando Valley urging them to do the same.
