**PROPOSED MOTION:** That the GCGC Board hereby approves a general letter to be drafted and sent to both the elected officials of the State of California, The California Governor and those of the City of Los Angeles denouncing the release of more than 6,500+ inmates from California prisons, under the supervision of the Department of Corrections. Our board in writing this letter hereby supports both the Sheriff of Los Angeles County, Lee Baca and the Chief of the Los Angeles Police Department, Charlie Beck, whom both protest the release of these prisoners. The GVGC Board hereby also objects to the change in status of more than 7,700+ inmates that have been released from the California prisons. This change in status would be from that of "Supervised" to that of "Non Supervision."
