Proposed Motion re Candidate Forum

To be submitted to the GVGC President at least 120 hours in advance of monthly Board meeting. Not to exceed 2 pages.

PROPOSED MOTION: that the Greater Valley Glen Council authorize GVGC co-sponsorship of a candidate debate or forum between the 2 finalists candidates, in the event that a run-off election is required after the September 22, 2009 election, for the 2nd District Council seat set for Valley College Monarch Hall on Monday, November 30, 2009; and

That the proposed candidate debate or forum may be co-sponsored by other neighborhood councils and the Associated Student Union of Los Angeles Valley College; and

That a sum not to exceed \$2,500 be appropriated for the total GVGC costs associated with the proposed event, and that said sum shall also include the expenses associates with some Community Outreach which also will highlight other upcoming GVGC programs, activities and events as well as the costs actually associated with co-sponsorship of the proposed Candidate debate or forum; and

That all said specific expenses shall be paid pursuant to approval of the GVGC Community Outreach and Neighborhoods Committee by Committee Resolution forwarded to the GVGC Treasurer.
