Construction Activity

- Construction of green stormwater infrastructure in public streets along Victory Boulevard (residential arterial), Goodland Avenue, Gilmore Street and Babcock Avenue
- Use of heavy equipment
- Drilling
- Pipe and drywell installation
- Asphalt paving, inlet construction
- Deliveries of construction materials
- Median improvements



Impacts

- Intermittent street or lane closures for local streets during construction hours
- Intermittent temporary parking restrictions in construction work zones
- “No Parking” signs will be posted at least three days in advance advising motorists to adhere to dates and hours of restrictions.
- There will be noise, dust and vibration associated with these construction activities. Standard mitigation measures will be applied during the project.
- Driveway access, trash and delivery services will not be affected.
