Motion stating that the Greater Valley Glen Council Board supports the following Best Landscape Award mission statement: In order to promote and encourage outstanding landscaping in Greater Valley Glen, and to foster community pride, the Parks & Improvement Committee of the GVGC shall nominate a "Best Landscape" award periodically to residential, commercial and other properties in each of the six districts. Due to the current drought conditions, the Committee shall give special consideration to landscapes that include drought tolerant planting and promote water conservation.

Proposed Community Impact Statement: Since the Best Landscape award provided recognition to those individuals/businesses that show pride in their properties, a clarified mission statement is warranted so everyone understands what the GVGC is attempting to promote.

Motion stating that the Greater Valley Glen Council supports the Budget Advocate's letter dated 11/10/2014 (see addendum A) and the of the Board Of Neighborhood Commissioners (BONC) letter dated 11/12/2014, requesting 6 new Exempt or Emergency Appointment positions be allocated to DONE. DONE is severely under staffed with only 1 supervisor and 5 field staff to cover and support 95 neighborhood councils and has experienced a 70% cut in staff since 2004. (Council File 14-0600-S142)

<u>Proposed Communit Impact Statement</u>: Council File 14-0600-S142 - The Greater Valley Glen Council supports 6 new Exempt or Emergency Appointment positions be allocated to the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE). DONE has experienced a 70% cut in staff since 2004 and has reached the point where it may not be able to fulfill its Charter mandated responsibilities to foster and support Neighborhood Councils.
