## Government Relations Committee - Judy Price, Chair

a. Motion stating that the Greater Valley Glen Council supports the City Council Motion to prepare an ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to eliminate any fees associated with the installation of approved "simple" graywater systems by homeowners in Los Angeles. (Council File #15-0458-S1).

Community Impact Statement: With the historic drought and water supplies dwindling, it is imperative to find creative solutions in the City of Los Angeles. Every incentive should be afforded the homeowner to encourage water-saving measures. To eliminate any fees associated with the installation of DWP approved "simple" graywater systems would encourage people to recycle water at their homes with graywater systems. (Council File #15-0458-S1)

- **b.** Motion stating that the Greater Valley Glen Council supports the City Council Resolution opposing the State Assembly Bill AB 1220 (Harper) which would prohibit local governments, cities, and counties, including charter cities, from levying local hotel taxes on "short term rentals". (Council File #15-0002-S31)
  - COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT: State Assembly Bill AB 1220 would eliminate local authority to collect revenue on short term rental, thereby undermining local control, local budgets, regulatory authority and land use control, and ultimately the principle of home rule. (Council File #15-0002-S31)
- c. Motion stating that the Greater Valley Glen Council supports the proposal to instruct the City Administrative Officer to review the recommendations in the Neighborhood Council Budget Advocates' 2015 White Paper and provide additional feedback for consideration in the budget process for the 2015-16 Fiscal Year. (Council File #15-0273)
  - COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT: The Neighborhood Council Budget Advocates are in the unique position of determining the budget priorities for the Neighborhood Councils along with suggestions for improving City services. This perspective should be utilized as the valuable tool that it is in determining the budget for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year. (Council File #15-0273)
- **d.** Motion approving the allocation of the following amounts of any unallocated or unused funds from our 2014-2015 budget:
  - a. 1. \$1000. to the Congress of Neighborhood Councils 2015.
  - b. 2. \$ 250. to the Neighborhood Council Budget Advocates.
