Motion 1: After reviewing the Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Draft Environmental Impact Report for Metro's proposed <u>East Valley Transit Corridor Project</u>, the Greater Valley Glen Council expresses its preference for a Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) alternative as meeting project's goals; being cost effective, operationally flexible, and least disruptive to adjoining residences and business; and realizable in a timely manner. Furthermore, all due consideration should be given for the use of all-electric buses in place of those powered by compressed natural gas (CNG). This position is to be forwarded to Metro before the October 16, 2017 deadline for comments on the DEIS/DEIR.
