  - Motion 1: The Greater Valley Glen Council endorses extension of LAMC 85.02 restricting the use of a vehicle for dwelling in City areas as prescribed, but asks that the description of dwelling be strengthened to to include immediately adjacent to a vehicle in addition to in or on when sitting—activities indicative of use of a vehicle for dwelling. Additionally, consideration of additional Safe Parking sites be held in abeyance pending the requested reporting from the various relevant departments regarding the current enforcement of LAMC 85.02 and the proposed enlarged enforcement zones surrounding Safe Parking sites. (CFs 14-1057-S4 and 18-0359)
  - 2. **Motion 2:** Illegal use of fireworks within the Greater Valley Glen Council area and surrounding areas is a cause for chronic complaints and one that the police find hard to counter as they need to witness the actual offense. The Greater Valley Glen Council endorses adding the inclusion "illegal use of fireworks" into the enforcement provisions of the Administrative Citation Enforcement (ACE) Program (CF 14-0818-S5).
