Motion to move that the City Council APPROVE \$3,861,565 from the Additional Homeless Services General City Purposes Fund No. 100/56, Account No. 000931 for a Council District 4 Encampment to Home Program; I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council INSTRUCT the Controller to establish a new account in Los Angeles Housing Department Fund No. 10A/43,43VXXX, titled "CD 4 Encampment to Home" and to transfer \$3,861,565 from the Additional Homeless Services General City Purposes Fund No. 100/56, Account No. 000931 to the new account established in 10A/43 for this purpose;
  - 1 FURTHER MOVE that the City Council INSTRUCT the General Manager ofthe Los Angeles Housing Department, or designee, to amend the City's 2021-22 General Fund contract with the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, C-138630, to increase funding by \$3,861,565 for a "Council District 4 Encampment to Home Program"; and I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council REQUEST that the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority execute a new or amend an existing sole source subcontract with The People Concern for an amount of \$3,861,565 for the term of October 1, 2021 June 30, 2022 to implement the Council District 4 Encampment to Home Program.
  - 5. Discussion and possible motion re: Council File: <u>15-0129-S1</u>. Motion to move that the Council direct the Planning Department and Housing and Community investment Department, in consultation with the City Attorney, to prepare and present a permanent ordinance to implement the <u>Mello Act</u>, including a requirement for all new housing developments that are subject to the Mello Act to provide affordable housing.

Discussion and possible motion re: <u>AB1164</u>: An act to add Section 53087.7 to the Government Code, relating to water conservation, and declaring the urgency thereof, to take effect immediately. This bill would prohibit a city, including a charter city, county, and city and county, from enacting or enforcing any ordinance or regulation that prohibits the installation of drought tolerant landscaping, synthetic grass, or artificial turf on residential property, as specified. The bill would additionally state that this is an issue of statewide concern. This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.
