## 6. Stop sign request

There are two intersections in my neighborhood that are 2-way stops but they are not posted as 2-way stops, which makes driving and walking in the area dangerous.

1. Longridge and Sylvan Intersection. Vehicles driving north-south on Longridge must stop and have stop signs. However, vehicles driving east-west on Sylvan do not need to stop and don't have stop signs. This intersection needs a 2-way sign added under its existing stop signs on Longridge, see sample picture below.

2. Mary Ellen and Sylvan Intersection. Vehicles driving north-south on Mary Ellen must stop and have stop signs. However, vehicles driving east-west on Sylvan do not need to stop and don't have stop signs. This intersection needs a 2-way sign added under its existing stop signs on Mary Ellen.

3. Longridge and Erwin Intersection. Vehicles driving north-south on Longridge must stop and have stop signs. However, vehicles driving east-west on Erwin do not need to stop and don't have stop signs. This intersection needs two 2-way sign added under its existing stop signs on Longridge.

It would be helpful to have 2-way stop signs posted underneath the current Stop signs on both Longridge intersections and Mary Ellen. This would mean 6 total 2-way signs would need to be added.
