The committee discussed the Los Angeles Times Op Ed piece on 2/19/20 and Andrea will also follow up with Assemblymember Laura Friedman to find out more detail about AB2121.

Mr. Jannol suggested starting a neighborhood watch on the block near Maggy Haves school to ensure continued police enforcement of speeders.

Committee members will reach out to other NCs in the immediate east valley area to find out if there are shared concerns about excessive speeding on major boulevards, and to gauge support and interest for increased enforcement by speeding cameras and revisitation of 85% rule (see [Op Ed](#)).

Discussion of what can be done in short term: Potential pilot program of cameras, and coordination with other NCs around traffic safety.
